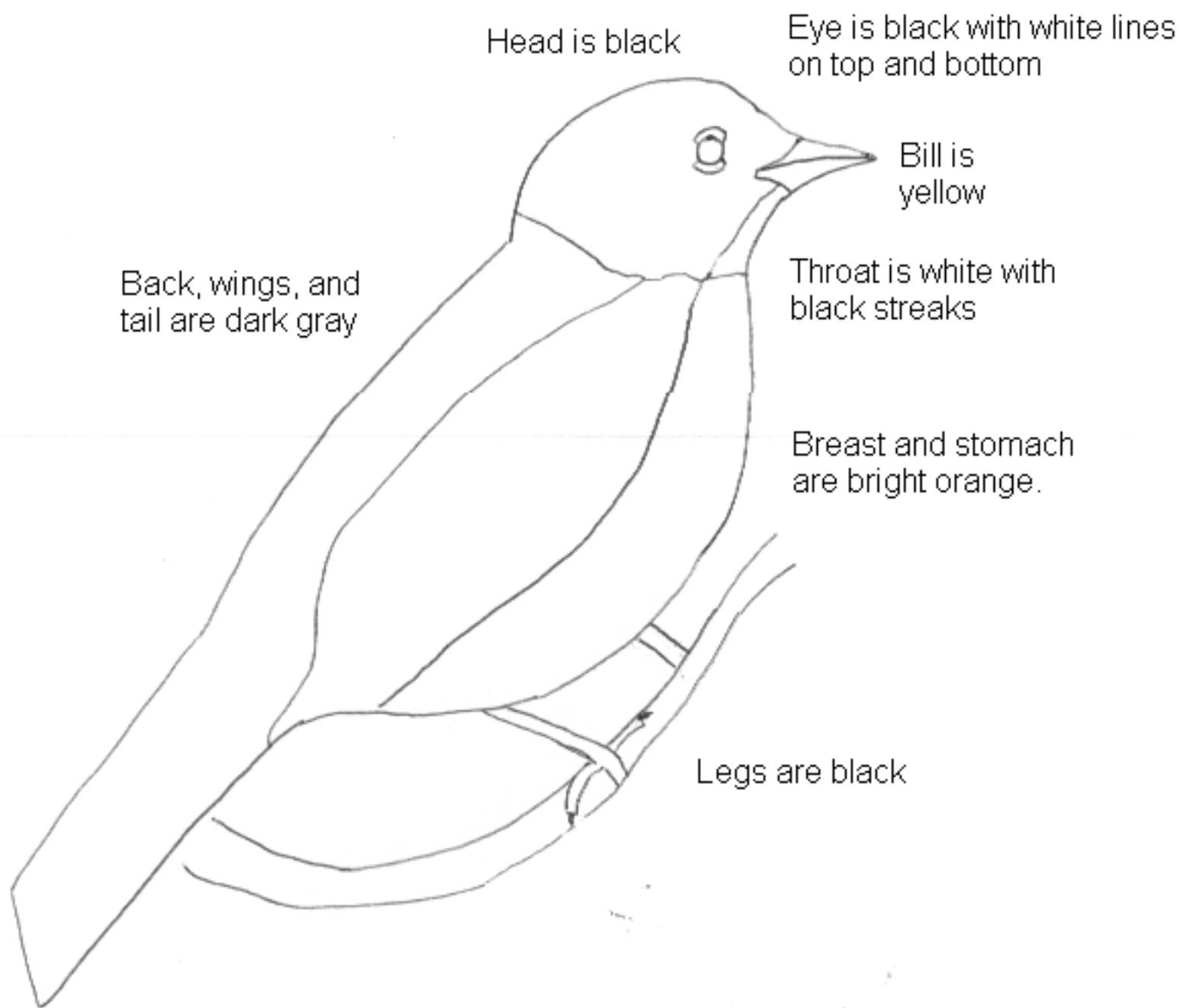


## American Robin



The American Robin may be the most recognizable bird in America. Common in gardens and neighborhoods as well as deep forests across the eastern and central United States and Canada, the Robin's characteristic "hop, hop, hop and stop" method of hunting earthworms is most familiar. The Robin is actually a member of the thrush family, and may form large flocks in the winter. Robins sometimes nest in unusual places such as wreaths, mailboxes, gutters, and boxes.
